### **TIRE AND PROPANE CYLINDER FEES: No Cash Accepted - Fees Must Be Paid By Punch Card**

- Truck Tires and 20 lb. Propane Cylinders \$2.00 each
- Commercial Truck Tires (20" and Up) and Equipment Tires \$10.00 each
